

“Talking Points” re “Planned Parenthood Day” Committee Resolutions (HCR 66 / SCR 46):

1. Planned Parenthood owes its existence to Margaret Sanger, who, by her writings, was clearly a racist and elitist, and felt that abortion was an acceptable means for eugenic ends. This has led to Black Americans nationwide having 2.3 times as many abortions (on a population basis) as Whites [CDC data].
2. Planned Parenthood promotes abortion-on-demand, and, through its “clinics” performs upwards of a quarter million abortions annually.
3. Planned Parenthood has resisted all objective informed consent for women contemplating abortion, as well as *any* regulations for abortion facilities, even those making the procedure safer for the mothers.
4. Planned Parenthood tries to sell the concept of abortion-for-convenience to high school girls indiscriminately (by mail), i.e. to any whose addresses they can discover.
5. Establishing a “Planned Parenthood Day” is totally contrary to reason, as well as the sense of most Americans. Far better would be the establishment of a “Respect-for- Life Day,” which would honor the lives of all from fertilization until a natural death.
